The snake-shaped counter platinum is richly engraved. The wooden stick and the large trigger guard are typical of these weapons.

Made with a walnut mount and a brown tan barrel, this rifle can take part in shooting competitions in the category "Manton R" or can be used in hunting, whether it is loaded with pellets or with a round bullet.

Faithful reproduction of a type of draft gun used in trade between the large trading companies (Northwest Co., Hudson's Bay Co., American Fur Co.) and Indians and Trappers.

These rustic rifles retained the classic line of European rifles and American manufacturers such as Leman, Henry, Tryon and Deringer.

The kit version is delivered with metal nails allowing the realization of drawings evoking for example the culture of Sioux Lakota. The most common ornament was a circle encompassing a cross symbolizing "the wheel of knowledge" or "the sacred circle of life" (Cangleska Wakan). It evokes the harmony of the universe and movement through the circular shape. The cross corresponds to the four cardinal directions supporting creation, thus giving it stability.

The number four can refer to the seasons, the phases of the day of human existence, the parts of a tree, or the human races.
