These cases are specially machined to be compatible with the chambers of **Sharps percussion rifles** from the years 1859 to 1863. They allow a **realistic shooting experience** with .54 type hollow skirt projectiles or historical ogival bullets.

Original format for traditional reloading

The .547 diameter and **internal cylindrical shape** are consistent with historical cartridge cases. They are designed to accommodate a black powder charge and a bullet without an integrated primer (primer on the nipple of the lock plate).

Reusable and robust

Made from **thick brass**, these cases withstand numerous reloading cycles. Their smooth surface minimizes fouling, and their shape ensures **easy extraction** after firing. Proper maintenance guarantees multiple uses.

FAQ

- **Are these cartridge cases primed?**
No, they are **unprimed** and designed for chimney-type turntables.
- **Are they compatible with modern rifles?**
Only with **Sharps percussion replicas** in .54 caliber.

- **How many times can they be reused?**

With proper care, they can **be reused many times** .
