An ideal muzzle brake for all types of hunting and shooting!

Stalon muzzle brakes reduce the majority of the recoil felt when firing (65%). The vents are adjustable with the screws provided.

- Excellent reduction of recoil and muzzle rise
- Small and lightweight design
- Reduced weight: 65-68 grams depending on caliber and threading
- Made of steel
- Aesthetically pleasing chamfer to ensure the muzzle brake fits the barrel's curves as closely as possible.
- bronze color

The muzzle brake comes with seven vent adjustment screws. These screws can be installed on the muzzle brake as desired. Before installing these screws, Stalon recommends testing the firearm without adjusting the muzzle brake, as in many cases the adjustment screws are not necessary.

The adjustment screws are installed on the lower part of the muzzle brake to limit muzzle rise during firing. Do not install all the screws at once: start with 3 or 4, then increase the number until the desired level of muzzle rise is achieved.

After fitting a muzzle brake, it is important to test the weapon again, as the point of impact may have shifted on the target.
