This is one of the first muzzle loading revolving carbines. It differentiates itself for its easy handling and reliability.

This replica by Uberti of the "carbine" version of the Remington 1858 New Army revolver is intended for precision shooting. Offered here in .44 caliber, with a 46 cm (18 inch) barrel, this rifle has been given an "old west antique" finish giving this weapon a decorative potential that looks great in an interior decorated according to a "Conquest of the Empire" theme. 'West'.

To simplify loading, the barrel can be quickly extracted and put back in place. Some users also had several preloaded barrels that they could change in a few seconds!

This barrel rifle, derived from the famous 1858 Army, was one of the first of its kind. Produced to order between 1866 and 1879, approximately 3,000 examples of this weapon left the production lines of the Remington factories. This reproduction of an exceptional historical weapon is characterized by its reliability, durability and ease of handling.
