The **Borner XSB1 4.5mm 7.5J air rifle** is an ideal air gun for getting started in recreational shooting or training with ease.

Compact and well-balanced, this air rifle is perfect for beginners or for practicing **target shooting** at short and medium ranges. Its **4.5 mm** caliber is the most common in airguns, easy to find, and economical to use.

Controlled and legal power

With an **energy of 7.5 joules**, it complies with legal limits in many countries and does not require registration in France. It is nevertheless powerful enough to penetrate cardboard or light metal targets up to 25-30 meters.

Enhanced accuracy thanks to a rifled barrel

Its **rifled steel barrel** provides better pellet stability thanks to the spin it imparts. This technical detail significantly improves accuracy with each shot, even for an entry-level rifle.

Safety and intuitive aiming

The **automatic safety** engages each time the weapon is cocked, blocking the trigger to prevent accidental firing. The **front and rear sights with colored inserts** allow for **quick and natural aiming**, even in low-light conditions. A **scope rail** also allows for the use of optics.

FAQ

Is the Borner XSB1 rifle declarable?

No, with a power of 7.5 joules, it is in category D and can be purchased by an adult without declaration.

Can a scope be mounted on this rifle?

Yes, the XSB1 has an optical rail allowing the installation of a standard riflescope.

What type of ammunition should be used?

4.5 mm (.177) caliber pellets, diabolo type or pointed, depending on the intended use (target or plinking).
