A backpack-style carrying system that frees up hands and arms during travel.

Niggeloh Backpack : This **rifle sling**, designed for back carrying, frees up hands and arms during movement. Its quick-release side buckles facilitate access to the weapon, and it weighs only 210 g.

A back carrier to keep your hands free

The **Niggeloh Backpack** adopts a **back-carrying system for the weapon** . Its advantage is particularly apparent during movement when the hands need to remain free. This is especially relevant in mountainous terrain or when searching for wounded game, two uses explicitly designed for this sling.

Quick access thanks to the side openings

Carrying a weapon on your back doesn't have to require a lengthy process to access it. **Quick-release side loops** , positioned in the center of the sling, allow for rapid release of the carrying system, enabling easy access to the weapon. This design combines back carrying with readily available equipment when the situation demands it.

Only 210g for the carrying equipment

Weighing in at a claimed **210g** , this **rifle sling** adds minimal weight to the carried equipment. This feature is particularly useful during extended hikes, especially in the mountains, where the weight of various accessories quickly adds up.

Three colors to complete your equipment

The range is available in **black, green, or brown** . Three variations that allow you to select the finish that corresponds to the equipment and the user's preferences, without changing the Backpack carrying principle.

FAQ

Why use a rifle sling with a back carry in the mountains?

Carrying the pack on your back allows you to keep your hands and arms free while moving. This design is therefore particularly advantageous for travel in mountainous terrain, which is the intended use of this system.

How can you access the weapon when it is carried on your back?

The system features quick-release side loops located in the center of the sling. These allow for rapid release of the sling in order to retrieve the weapon.

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
