A semi-automatic rifle inspired by the legendary AK47, the WBP Jack offers a reliable 5.45x39 caliber platform with rugged polymer furniture and a side rail for mounting optics.

Suitable for fans of modernized Soviet platforms, this semi-automatic rifle in **5.45x39** caliber combines the ergonomics of polymer with the robustness of stamped steel. Its **integrated side rail** allows the simple addition of a scope or a red dot, without altering the balance of the weapon. This compact and reliable model is designed for use in ranges or supervised sport shooting, in compliance with current regulations.

- **Carcass:** stamped steel according to AKM standards
- **Furniture:** Handguard and stock made of durable polymer
- **Initial speed:** 715 m/s for a straight trajectory
- **Compatibility:** Accepts standard AK74 magazines
- **Manufacturing:** WBP factory equipped for maintenance and repair

The 5.45x39 mm caliber: precision and low recoil

Developed by the Soviet Union in the 1970s to replace the 7.62x39mm, the **5.45x39** caliber was designed to improve accuracy, reduce recoil, and provide a smoother trajectory over long distances. It is used in the AK-74 and remains popular today for **precision** and **dynamic shooting** thanks to its advantageous ballistic characteristics. Lighter than its predecessor, it allows for better control during rapid fire and increased ammunition capacity.

- **Origin:** Soviet standard of 1974
- **Use:** sport shooting, training on AK platform
- **Ballistic advantage:** low recoil, good stability
- **Distribution:** Widespread in Eastern countries

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
