The **1886 Pedersoli Sporting Fancy lever-action rifle** is a direct descendant of John Browning's inventions. Its robust and smooth design provides fast and consistent handling, making it a favorite with demanding shooters during target practice.

PMG octagonal barrel

The **PMG octagonal barrel** is machined with meticulous precision. This type of barrel promotes greater rigidity and harmonious vibration distribution, which improves impact consistency and aiming stability.

Finished in select American walnut

The **American walnut stock** chosen for the stock combines strength and aesthetics. The *English straight stock* version offers a classic line and a natural grip, ideal for precise shooting control and extended comfort at the range.

Forged and CNC machined

The receiver is **forged** and then **CNC machined**, guaranteeing both structural strength and perfect adjustments. This dual technique ensures exceptional durability and a fluidity of action that is felt with each lever operation.

Traditional and evolving aim

The rifle is equipped with a **blade front sight** and an **adjustable rear sight**, for fine adjustment of the trajectory. In addition, the receiver is **pre-drilled and tapped** to receive a diopter (peep sight), allowing the weapon to be adapted to the shooter's preferences and further improving accuracy.
