The **PEDERSOLI Scout Rifle Flintlock** is a muzzle-loading, flintlock ignition rifle, typical of the 1750-1850 period, designed for enthusiasts of classic shooting or reenactment.

A flintlock rifle, 18th-19th century style

With its reference period spanning 1750 to 1850, this rifle is part of the tradition of flintlock adventure and hunting rifles. It allows users to relive the sensations of an era when equipment was not simply about effectiveness, but about the art of shooting and stalking.

Muzzle loading and flintlock system

Muzzle loading requires precise preparation: powder, ball or sabot, wad, then priming with a flintlock. The flintlock mechanism offers a visible, more manual action that appeals to enthusiasts of traditional shooting and reenactments.

Long, rifled barrel for firing stability

With a **720 mm barrel** and a **1:48 twist rate (1200 mm)** , the weapon is designed for projectile stability over extended ranges. The seven grooves ensure consistent projectile rotation, contributing to the relative accuracy of this type of weapon.

Weight and dimensions for a balanced grip

Its overall length of 1090 mm and weight of 2.8 kg make it an imposing but well-balanced weapon, typical of period rifles. It is intended for a shooter who has the time to set up, rather than for quick or mobile use.

FAQ

- **Can it be used for modern hunting?**

No, this flintlock model is primarily intended for historical shooting enthusiasts, for leisure or reenactment, and not for contemporary hunting uses.

- **What type of approval or authorization is required?**

This is a black powder weapon with flint ignition, classified as available for sale to adults.

- **Is it suitable for historical reenactment?**

Yes, thanks to its faithful mechanics, its reference period and its typical characteristics, it is particularly interesting for enthusiasts of historical reenactment.
