### A faithful and compact kit for 1750-1850 reenactment.

This pistol kit is a careful reproduction of the period "Kentucky" model from 1750-1850, delivered for assembly and finishing by the user.

- **Caliber:** .45
- **Year of origin:** 1750-1850
- **Ignition system:** flintlock
- **Number of stripes:** 12
- **Torsion:** 450 mm (1:18?)
- **Barrel length:** 264 mm (10 3/8?)
- **Total length:** 390 mm (15 3/8?)
- **Weight:** 1.000 kg (2.31 lb)

### Usage and context

Designed for reenactment and collecting, this kit reproduces the proportions and operation of pistols from the period 1750-1850. Assembly and adjustments allow for an aesthetic and functional result, suitable for demonstrations and historical shooting ranges (compliance with regulations required).

### Canon and scratches

The 264 mm barrel combines compactness and stability. The **12 grooves** with a twist rate of **450 mm (1:18?)** provide stabilization suitable for the .45 caliber, optimizing accuracy when firing with black powder.

### Mechanism and ignition

The flintlock mechanism recreates the feel and ergonomics of old weapons: trajectory, ignition time and maintenance specific to black powder must be respected by the user.

### Wood and finish

The **maple** handle provides an authentic silhouette and a comfortable grip. The kit allows for customization of the finish (sanding, staining, patina) according to scenographic or museum applications.

- **Kit includes:** wooden and metal parts for assembly
- **Wood:** maple for the stock and grip
- **Metal:** steel barrel and treated mechanism
- **Assembly:** requires basic tools and assembly skills

## FAQ

- **Q: Do I need permission to buy it?**

Check French regulations: some kits and replicas may require special conditions (declaration, category).

- **Q: Is it available in other calibers?**

Variations exist (e.g. .50, .54) depending on the catalogues — check supplier availability.

- **Q: What kind of maintenance should be planned?**

Cleaning after firing with a brush and oiling; special attention should be paid to black powder to avoid corrosion and deposits.
