A high-performance barrel for slug shooting

Thanks to its **762 mm octagonal barrel** with 6 grooves and a **fast 1:24" twist rate**, this rifle ensures optimal stabilization of conical bullets. This technical choice allows for accurate shooting at medium and long ranges in .50 caliber.

Comfort and historical aesthetics

The **American walnut stock** is crafted from select wood to combine ergonomics and authenticity. The case-hardened **furniture** provides a rustic and durable finish. The double set trigger allows for a light and controlled trigger pull.

A field weapon and a collector's item

Weighing **4.3 kg** , this rifle remains stable on the shoulder and absorbs recoil well, while maintaining the necessary balance for shooting from a standing or kneeling position. It is ideal for demanding shooters, reenactors, and enthusiasts of American history.
