Canon 6-inch and precision

The 6" (152 mm) barrel provides a comfortable sight picture for **precision shooting** at medium range. The **1:20 twist rate** ensures stability suitable for .44 Remington Magnum projectiles. The adjustable rear sight, equipped with fiber optics, allows for fine adjustments depending on the ammunition used.

High-strength materials and ergonomics

The **7075-T6** aircraft-grade alloy frame ensures rigidity and relative lightness for its size. The steel cylinder and barrel provide robustness and durability. The **Hogue® overmolded rubber grips**, with double finger rests, ensure a secure hold during intense sessions.

Nickel finish: aesthetics and durability

The **nickel/chrome** finish provides enhanced protection against oxidation while offering a modern and distinctive aesthetic. It's exactly the kind of finish that catches the eye in a shop window... while remaining perfectly functional for regular use at a trade show booth.

What are the conditions for acquiring this revolver?

This .44 Magnum caliber revolver is classified in category B. Its acquisition requires a valid prefectoral authorization, a valid sports shooting license and strict compliance with French regulations.

What advantage does the adjustable riser offer?

The adjustable elevation and windage sight allows for precise adjustment of the point of impact according to the ammunition used and the shooting distance, thus optimizing accuracy at the range.

Why does a low barrel axis improve shooting comfort?

By aligning the barrel with the lower part of the cylinder, the Rhino design reduces muzzle rise. Recoil is more direct and better controlled, improving stability and rapid follow-up shots in target shooting.
