The **BORNER CO2 Revolver 733** operates with **4.5 mm steel BBs** and a **CO2 cartridge**. Its predominantly metal construction, **6-shot cylinder**, and compact size offer excellent handling for **recreational target shooting**.

A compact replica for recreational shooting

The **BORNER CO2 733 revolver** incorporates the design of modern revolvers in a particularly compact format. Its natural balance and ergonomic grip provide a comfortable hold, suitable for both beginners and recreational shooters.

CO2 operation with 4.5 mm steel balls

This replica operates exclusively with **4.5 mm steel BBs** . Its barrel is designed for this type of ammunition only. The use of pellets is strictly prohibited, as it could damage the barrel. Powered by a CO2 cartridge, the revolver develops a velocity of up to **120 m/s** , ideal for target shooting at short and medium ranges.

6-shot cylinder

The cylinder holds **6 steel BBs** and offers simple and quick operation. This capacity, combined with the replica's compact size, provides a smooth and enjoyable shooting experience.

Two finishes available

The **733-B** features a sleek, modern black finish, while the **733-S** boasts a stainless steel finish with a wood-effect handle for a more classic look. Both versions share the same mechanical features and build quality.

A robust metal construction

The metal frame provides excellent handling and durability. Weighing **705g** for the black version and **728g** for the stainless steel version, the revolver maintains good balance while remaining comfortable during extended shooting sessions.

FAQ

What ammunition should be used with the BORNER 733?

The BORNER 733 uses only 4.5 mm steel BBs. 4.5 mm pellets must not be used, as they are incompatible with the barrel and may damage it.

What is the difference between the 733-B and 733-S versions?

The only difference is the finish. The 733-B is offered in black, while the 733-S is available in a stainless steel finish with a wood-effect handle.

Is this revolver suitable for target shooting?

Yes. Its CO2 operation, 5cm barrel and 4.5mm steel ball propulsion make it a model perfectly suited for recreational target shooting at short and medium range.

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
