Wood and metal to recapture the aesthetics of the 19th century

The combination of **wood** and **metal** contributes to the evocation of the historical model. Its length of 100 cm and its stated weight of 2,480 g also give this reproduction a substantial size, suitable for display in a collection dedicated to the **American Western** , historical weapons, or the 19th century.

The 1873 model occupies a special place in American popular culture. Produced on a large scale in its time, it became closely associated with the conquest of the West and notably inspired the film **Winchester '73** , directed by Anthony Mann in 1950 starring James Stewart.
