An iconic Texas percussion rifle

Inspired by the weapons used at the Battle of the Alamo in 1836, the **PEDERSOLI Alamo Percussion Rifle** embodies the technological evolution of the 19th century with its **percussion system**, more reliable than older flintlock mechanisms. Less susceptible to weathering, it marks a decisive step in the history of weaponry.

Rifled octagonal barrel: precision and stability

Its 915 mm **blued steel octagonal barrel**, with **8 grooves** at a **1:48" pitch**, ensures excellent stabilization of .45 caliber projectiles. This configuration is particularly appreciated in **black powder shooting**, offering regular groups and a controlled trajectory at medium range.

Double trigger with adjustable set trigger

The **double set trigger** ensures a clean and precise shot. In practice, the finesse of the mechanism is immediately apparent: control is optimal, whether for target shooting or reenactment demonstrations.

High-quality finish and historical engravings

The **walnut stock** provides balance and elegance, while the engraved **patch box** depicts two iconic scenes: the resistance at the Alamo and General Sam Houston's victory at San Jacinto. A detail that will appeal to enthusiasts of **American military history**.

Use and maintenance

This model is designed exclusively for **black powder shooting** with components adapted to the .45 caliber (compatible bullet type USA520-445, USA470 nipple). Meticulous cleaning after each use is essential to protect the barrel and mechanical parts from corrosion caused by combustion residue.

What powder should I use with this Alamo rifle?

This model operates exclusively with black powder suitable for .45 caliber, in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations.

Is this rifle suitable for historical reenactment?

Yes, its faithful design, engraved patch box and finish respectful of period standards make it an ideal piece for the reenactment of the Texas War of Independence.

What maintenance is required after shooting?

A thorough cleaning of the barrel and mechanism after each use is essential to remove black powder residue and prevent corrosion.
