OVERVIEW
The AK-47 is a 7.62 mm assault rifle developed in the Soviet Union by Mikhail Kalashnikov in the late 1940s. The rifle is a gas-operated, magazine-fed, select-fire rifle. It is the most produced rifle in the world, with over 100 million units produced.

DISASSEMBLY
Disassembling the rifle involves the operator disassembling the magazine, the receiver, the trigger, the hammer, the bolt, and the gas piston. The operator must follow the steps in the manual to ensure the rifle is safely disassembled.
